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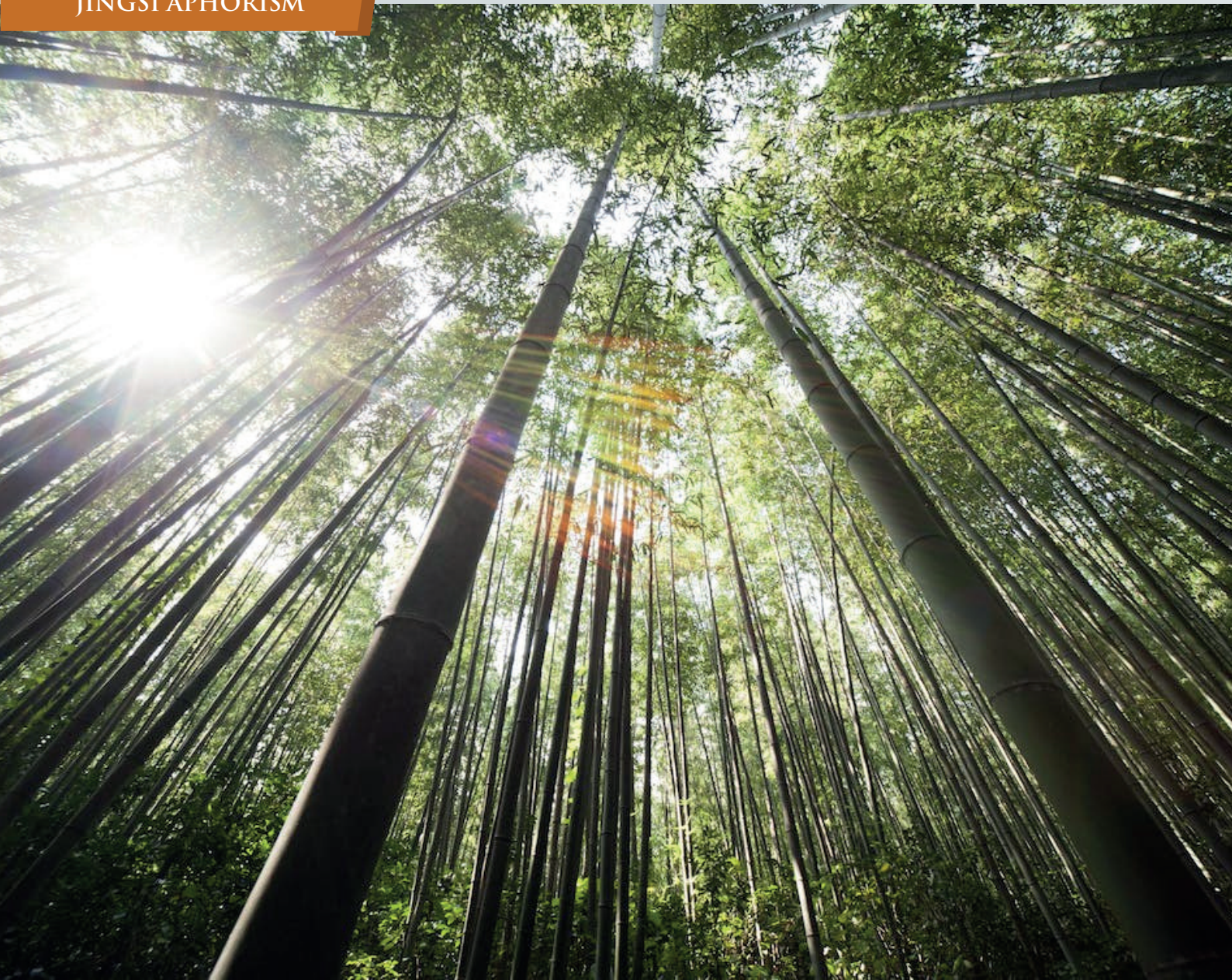
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A Tzu Chi volunteer in a leadership position told Master of his difficulties with interpersonal relationships.

Guest Visit

The occupation month was packed with parents sharing about their job. But wait, there's more! The students were given the opportunity to share about what they like to be when they grow up. We also invited a special guest.

Last January 30, 2023, the students came to school in their occupation costumes, and did some activities in the class. It was so exciting to see the astronauts, policemen, scientists, and chefs go to school on that day. The activities included show and tell, art and crafts, games, and of course attending activities with the guests. This time, we invited an architect to our school. She shared about her job, what she makes, and what an architect does.

The activities were divided into three sessions. The first session was for N2 students, the second session was for K1 students, and the third session was for K2 students. When the students came, Ms Anindya and her friend Ms Cindy, introduced themselves. Using the PPT she showed the students what an architect does. The simple explanation about her job is that an architect makes spaces. An architect designs buildings, houses, offices or even playgrounds. She showed one sample of her works. Then came the exciting part. Ms. Anindya

divided the room into two corners. The classes chose the corner of activities they wanted to do.

There were modeling and drawing stations at each corner. In the modeling corner, our guests prepared a landscape of a playground, then students completed the playground with toys, benches, or anything with their imagination. They used playdough and some sticks assisted by the class teachers. They made trees, benches, slides, etc. The second corner was the drawing corner. Our guests stuck paper on the wall around the room. The students drew houses, boxed playgrounds, or anything they wanted using the colored pencils, crayons, and rulers they brought. The students were so excited to do the activities. They drew houses, gardens, and even 3D shapes.



Before the guest visit ended, Ms Cindy asked several questions about her job, which the students eagerly answered by raising their hands. From the students' faces, they seemed to really enjoy this activity.

Peranan Orang Tua dalam Memaksimalkan Tumbuh Kembang Anak

Mengawali tahun baru 2023 di triwulan 3 ini, sekolah menyelenggarakan webinar bagi para orang tua murid yang disampaikan langsung oleh Dr. Rose Mini Agoes Salim M.Psi., Psikolog atau yang akrab dipanggil Bunda Romi, dari Fakultas Psikologi UI pada hari Jumat, tanggal 27 Januari 2023 pukul 13.30 hingga 14.30 WIB. Webinar ini dihadiri kurang lebih 114 orang menggunakan aplikasi zoom meeting.

Ada beberapa hal yang menjadi catatan penting yang disampaikan oleh Bunda Romi. Di antaranya yaitu:

- 1) Perkembangan otak anak pada usia *the golden age*,
- 2) Pentingnya stimulasi pada berbagai area perkembangan anak,
- 3) Sekolah bukan oven ajaib yang langsung mengubah dan mengembangkan anak dalam sekejap waktu,
- 4) Orang tua perlu ikut ambil bagian dalam menyediakan fasilitas dan kesempatan agar anak-anak berlatih dan terstimulasi,

- 5) Kedekatan orang tua dan anak turut memberikan sumbangsih bagi tumbuh-kembang anak,
- 6) Mengubah perilaku anak harus dimulai dengan mengubah input, sama seperti mengikuti teori stimulus *input, operant, dan response*,
- 7) Menumbuhkan rasa percaya diri anak dengan membiasakan anak mengambil atau membuat putusannya sendiri.

Demikian pentingnya pertumbuhan otak anak pada masa *the golden age* (usia 2 hingga 6 tahun), maka anak harus mendapatkan segala kegiatan, stimulasi, dan pengalaman yang baik, positif, dan berguna demi tumbuh-kembangnya yang seimbang dan sempurna.

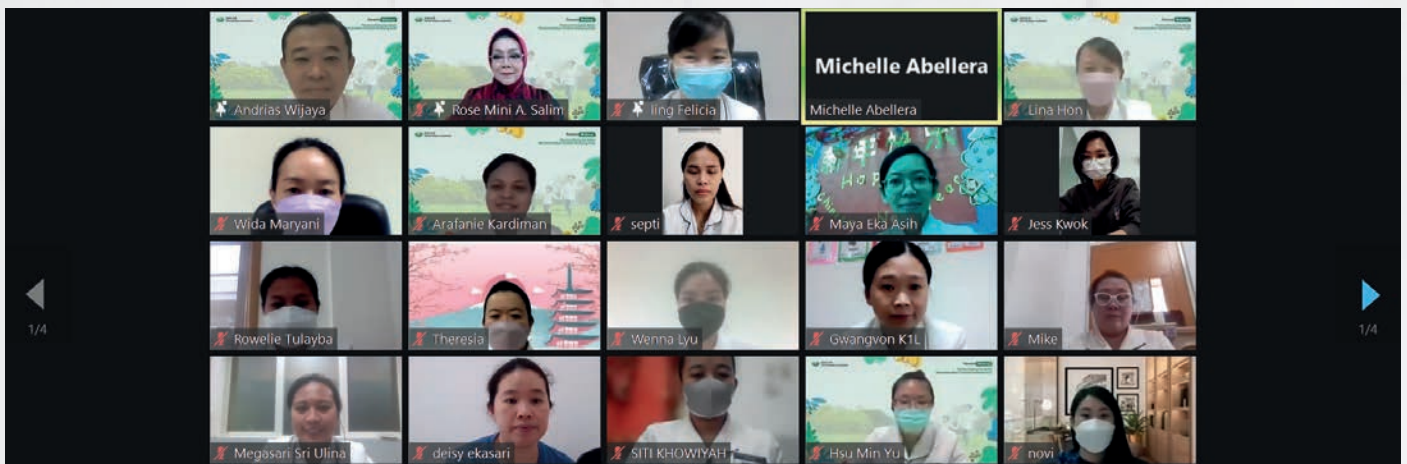
Kebutuhan anak yang terutama dalam tumbuh-kembangnya adalah stimulasi sensoris, motor, emosional, kognisi, dan sosial. Anak-anak perlu mendapatkan banyak kesempatan dan latihan di rumah untuk menstimulasi dirinya agar seluruh anggota tubuhnya dapat bertumbuh

dan berkembang sesuai fungsinya masing-masing dengan baik. Sementara sekolah bukanlah oven ajaib yang dapat mengubah kondisi anak secara langsung dan begitu saja. Tumbuh kembang anak membutuhkan waktu, proses, dan kerja sama dengan pihak keluarga dan khususnya orang tua yang mendampingi anaknya setiap hari. Orang tua perlu tahu benar akan kondisi dan kebutuhan anak.

Orang tua perlu menciptakan banyak kesempatan stimulasi untuk anak-anaknya dan juga perlu memberikan motivasi atau dorongan agar mau bergerak, berlatih, dan juga belajar untuk ambil bagian dengan kegiatan keseharian di rumah, sehingga sensori dan motor anak menjadi terstimulasi dengan baik. Kedekatan antara orang tua dan anak memberikan faktor utama yang sangat penting dalam tumbuh kembang anak sehingga tercipta rasa percaya diri untuk melakukan tugas dan kegiatannya.

Untuk mengubah perilaku anak harus diketahui apa yang menjadi kondisi dan penyebabnya, kemudian mengubah faktor utama yang menyebabkan perilaku lama, sehingga dan diharapkan tercipta perilaku atau kebiasaan baik yang baru. Anak-anak perlu diberi kesempatan untuk memilih dan berkeputusan sendiri serta mengeksekusinya untuk membangun *self-esteem* agar anak tumbuh sehat seutuhnya.

Health Week

Dalam rangka “*Health Week*” di KB-TK Tzu Chi yang diselenggarakan pada tanggal 13 hingga 17 Februari 2023. Tzu Chi School bekerja sama dengan Tzu Chi Hospital dan Dr. Agatha Mulyo, SpKFR dari Klinik Agatha Pondok Indah untuk memberikan pelayanan kesehatan pada murid-murid dari level N1 hingga level K2 dengan melakukan pemeriksaan gigi, mata dan *body posture*.

Pengenalan tentang pentingnya kesehatan gigi perlu dilakukan sejak dini agar anak tidak takut atau merasa trauma saat mereka pergi ke dokter gigi untuk melakukan perawatan gigi. Anak-anak dengan gigi sehat tentu akan membuat mereka tidak kesulitan saat makan karena tidak merasa sakit. Pemeriksaan yang dilakukan sejak dini akan membantu melindungi dan mencegah kerusakan gigi pada anak. Hal ini harus diperhatikan, karena masalah gigi dan mulut bisa sangat mengganggu aktivitas belajar serta tumbuh kembang siswa-siswi.

Selama masa pandemi Covid-19, pembelajaran dilakukan dari rumah dengan menggunakan metode kegiatan dan belajar secara daring. Selama jam

pelajaran ditambah dengan kebiasaan bermain gawai membuat kesehatan mata anak harus diwaspadai. Hal ini sangat penting, karena sangat berpengaruh pada kesehatan mata dan tumbuh kembang mereka. Selain memeriksa gigi anak, juga dilakukan pemeriksaan mata. Memastikan mata anak sehat dan tidak memiliki masalah penglihatan yang dapat mempengaruhi kesehatan anak, serta berpotensi mengganggu kegiatan belajar anak.

Sebelum memasuki usia balita, bayi yang baru lahir sebenarnya sudah mulai menunjukkan postur yang benar. Seiring bertambahnya usia, saat anak memasuki balita, postur tubuh yang baik miliknya juga ikut berkembang. Biasanya, di usia balita ini, tubuh anak sudah jauh lebih berisi. Masa kanak-kanak adalah masa pertumbuhan dan pembentukan postur tubuh yang sangat signifikan. Oleh sebab itu, orangtua harus memperhatikan asupan nutrisi serta kebiasaan anak yang dapat mendukung pertumbuhan anak agar tumbuh dengan optimal. Perkembangan ukuran dan proporsi tubuh erat kaitannya dengan keterbentukan setiap individu ke arah tipe bentuk tubuh. Bentuk tubuh seseorang merupakan wujud dari perpaduan dari tinggi badan, berat badan serta berbagai ukuran antropometrik lainnya yang ada pada diri seseorang. Dengan memiliki postur tubuh yang baik dapat meningkatkan kemampuan tubuh untuk menjaga kesehatan tulang dan sendi.

Diadakannya *Healthy Week* ini, memiliki harapan agar siswa-siswi KB-TK Tzu Chi dapat tumbuh dan berkembang dengan optimal. Karena “sehat dimulai dari saya”.

Nanny Workshop Karakter Positif, Dimulai dari Sekarang

Setiap anak memiliki karakter yang beragam yang menjadikan dirinya unik. Baik orang tua, guru maupun pengasuh menginginkan yang terbaik untuk anak, mengharapkan siswa-siswi memiliki karakter yang positif. Karakter positif pada anak dapat membantu mereka dalam menjalani kehidupan; dan anak yang memiliki karakter positif cenderung akan lebih berhasil dalam hubungan interpersonal, baik di dalam maupun di luar rumah. Selain, karakter positif dapat membuat anak cenderung memiliki sikap yang lebih ramah, berbelas kasih, kooperatif, dan menghormati orang lain.

Untuk itu, TK Tzu Chi pada hari Rabu, tanggal 15 Maret 2023 mengadakan Nanny Workshop di triwulan ketiga ini. Mengusung tema: “Karakter Positif, Dimulai dari Sekarang!” dilaksanakan di ruang tunggu TK.

Peserta diajak untuk melatih konsentrasi dengan menggunakan permainan angka dilanjutkan berdiskusi tentang definisi karakter. Mengenal dan mengupas pentingnya karakter, juga pentingnya peran pendidikan karakter terhadap proses tumbuh kembang anak. Mengapa pendidikan karakter penting diajarkan kepada anak-anak? Karena sebagai bekal fondasi anak di masa depan. Pembentukan karakter anak dapat dipengaruhi oleh faktor *nature* atau yang dikenal sebagai faktor bawaan yang berasal dari warisan biologis atau dimiliki sejak lahir, serta dipengaruhi oleh faktor *nurture* yaitu mengacu



pada pengaruh lingkungan, seperti pengalaman hidup, pola pengasuhan saat kecil, pembelajaran, hubungan sosial, hingga kebudayaan lingkungan tempat tinggal, merupakan faktor eksternal yang bisa memengaruhi individu. Baik *nature* ataupun *nurture* merupakan dua hal yang saling mempengaruhi satu sama lain. Oleh karena itu, keseimbangan antara dua konsep ini perlu dijaga agar dapat membentuk perkembangan manusia secara optimal.

Selain menginginkan anak tumbuh menjadi generasi cerdas, setiap orang tua juga menginginkan anaknya memiliki karakter yang baik. Saat memasuki taman kanak-kanak, kemampuan berpikir anak akan meningkat secara pesat, dan dalam proses tumbuh kembangnya, anak akan belajar sesuatu melalui pengamatan terhadap sikap orang lain serta lingkungan. Untuk itu dalam mengajarkan pendidikan karakter pada anak, penting bagi dewasa bersikap sabar, empati, saling menghargai dan serta memberikan contoh baik untuk anak. Pengembangan karakter positif anak melalui pendidikan karakter dapat diterapkan dalam lingkungan rumah maupun sekolah. Cara mempraktikkannya di kehidupan sehari-hari dapat dimulai dari hal-hal kecil

seperti: membiasakan Ananda untuk mengucapkan *magic words*: terima kasih, tolong, dan minta maaf kepada orang lain. Biasakan Ananda juga untuk menjaga kebersihan rumah dengan menyusun kembali mainan yang telah ia mainkan.

Membentuk siswa yang berkarakter bukanlah instan. Dibutuhkan upaya terus menerus dan refleksi diri. Diperlukan waktu untuk membuat semua itu menjadi sebuah kebiasaan. Maka itu, untuk mengembangkan karakter positif, dimulai dari sekarang!

证严上人所示：『有心就有福，有愿就有力。』。无偿献血是传递爱心、拯救生命的崇高社会公益事业。印尼慈济国际学校于2023年2月11日，首次举办无偿献血活动。

为保证首次无偿献血活动的顺利开展，学校高度重视，负责人韩蓉蓉师姐与北一和气慈济志工团互相合作，制定了无偿献血活动方案及应急处理预案。慈济学校的老师们也以慈济志工的身份出现在活动现场，以实际行动助力无偿献血公益事业，为社会奉献一份爱心。

活动当天的早上7点钟，教师们冒着蒙蒙细雨，陆续来到学校大厅集合。北一和气慈济志工团的Yuli Natalia Cheng师姐激动地说：『很感恩，今天的活动有很多老师来帮忙，很高兴看到新老教师们加入我们的慈济志工团队，希望以后有更多的老师来参加志工活动。』。

前来献血的志愿者们也早早来到了活动现场-慈济小学的大厅，他们有慈济学校的教职员工、学生家长、学校保安以及社会民众。在志工们的暖心服务下，各项工作有条不紊，参

加献血的志愿者有序、间隔排队，填写登记表，在测量血压、抽血化验合格后分散就座，等候采血。工作人员在采血的同时，也时刻关注着献血者的身体状况，并交代一些关于献血的注意事项。

慈济学校的董事Sudino Lim也是献血志愿者中的一名，以实际行动奉献自己的爱心，同时，他也和其他的志工一起来关怀献血的志愿者们。很多慈济学校的家长是带着儿女们一起来的，让子女全程陪同，借此机会让子女了解无偿献血事业对于生命的重要性，用实际行动为孩子树立乐于奉献的榜样形象。在与志工们交谈中，一位社会民众志愿者说：“一份血液，一份爱心，无偿献血是利国利民的好事，只要我身体健康，我愿意献出自己的一份力量。有机会帮助别人，我觉得自己很幸福。”



为期半天的无偿献血活动在预期的时间内顺利完成。本次活动共有35名志工前来协助，分别为：28位志工和7位慈济高中学生。无偿献血志愿者共计118位，经过严格的体检后，献血成功的志愿者有79位。无偿献血，你我同行，感恩无偿献血的菩萨们以及前来协助的志工们。同时我们也号召更多的人加入无偿献血志愿者的行列，用爱心传递爱心；伸出你的手，让爱心为生命加油。

Membangkitkan Semangat Cinta Kasih

Di pagi yang cerah, para relawan Tzu Chi tengah berkumpul di depan Jing Si Hall, di antara mereka, ada beberapa guru-guru Tzu Chi School. Mereka datang dengan memakai seragam abu-abu, berpakaian rapi dan berbaris diantara para relawan Tzu Chi. Sesuai himbuan Master, bahwa pendidik seharusnya tidak hanya mengajar, namun hendaknya terjun ke tengah masyarakat untuk membantu orang-orang yang membutuhkan, dengan demikian diharapkan mereka dapat mengembangkan kebijaksanaan mereka. Hari ini, tanggal 8 Januari 2023 pukul 07:30 WIB, mereka dengan perasaan antusias datang untuk ikut melakukan kegiatan kunjungan kasih yang rutin dilakukan oleh para relawan Tzu Chi.

Setelah melakukan *briefing* dan pembagian tim, guru dan relawan bergegas menuju rumah para penerima bantuan. Melewati jalanan yang sempit, dengan rumah-rumah ala kadarnya, ada rumah berukuran kecil dan hanya setinggi 160 cm, ada yang hanya beratapkan

rotan, dan lain sebagainya. Guru bersama dengan para relawan Tzu Chi, mengamati lingkungan yang mereka lalui.

Setelah kembali ke Jing Si Hall, mereka berkumpul lagi di Galeri DaAi lantai 1, Gedung DaAi untuk melakukan diskusi dan paparan singkat tentang apa yang telah mereka lihat dan alami. Ms. Ling Felicia Joe, kepala sekolah TK Tzu Chi, berkata "suatu berkah saya diberikan kesehatan dan kesempatan untuk berbagi kasih, melakukan pendampingan dengan mereka yang membutuhkan. Yang paling saya syukuri adalah bagaimana saya terlibat dalam jalinan jodoh relawan Tzu Chi untuk ikut memberikan semangat kepada Bapak yang saat ini sedang *down*."

Ms. Atika Nirwana Sari, guru TK Tzu Chi School, juga memberikan presentasinya. Dia berkata: "Sangat berterimakasih diberi kesempatan untuk melakukan kunjungan kasih di awal tahun ini. Melihat gan en hu. Mengingat saya untuk selalu bersyukur. Melihat keadaan gan en hu saya merasa sedih, semoga beliau

bisa diberi kesehatan dan dapat bekerja seperti sedia kala. Kunjungan kasih ini juga merupakan pelatihan bagi diri saya untuk pribadi yang lebih baik.” Kunjungan kasih ini adalah kunjungan kasih pertama kali yang diikuti oleh Ms Atika. Walaupun panas terik matahari sangat menyengat tidak menggoyahkannya, Ms Atika pulang dengan rasa penuh syukur dan bahagia.

Tak hanya melakukan kunjungan kasih, mereka juga mengikuti beberapa kegiatan relawan, seperti daur ulang yang dilakukan setiap minggu ke 3 setiap bulannya, donor darah, dan pembagian paket Cinta Kasih di Kapuk.

“Apa yang kita kerjakan tidaklah sulit”, kata Alexandra Go, guru TK Tzu Chi School, “barang-barang yang diberikan juga tidaklah berharga bagi saya, tetapi sangat berharga dimata mereka yang menerima paket cinta kasih ini. Saya sangat terharu dan membangkitkan semangat saya untuk membantu orang yang membutuhkan” lanjutnya. Alexandra Go adalah salah seorang guru TK Tzu Chi School yang mengikuti kegiatan pembagian paket cinta kasih yang dibagikan pada tanggal 14 Januari 2023, di Vihara Hindu Dharma, Kapuk. Selain Alexandra Go juga masih ada 12 guru Tzu Chi School yang mengikuti kegiatan pembagian paket cinta kasih ini.

Di kegiatan daur ulang atau pelestarian lingkungan, guru-guru tidak hanya melakukan pemilahan sampah, mereka juga memilah dan meremas botol, seperti: memilah tutup botol, melepaskan plastik logo, meremas botol, membuang air, dan lain-lain. Terdengar ada seorang relawan guru yang berkata: “meremas botol



seperti kita sedang meremas dan membuang kerisauan kita.” Ada juga yang berkata: “Banyak juga botol yang harus kita pilah ya, kita hendaknya membawa botol sendiri, dan mencari cara sehingga kita dapat mengurangi sampah.” Di kegiatan daur ulang ini, para guru belajar hal-hal baru, seperti 5R yang diterapkan di Tzu Chi. Setelah Alex Shixiong selesai menjelaskan apa itu 5R, terdengar seorang guru berkata, ini dapat kita terapkan disekolah, dan dapat kita ajarkan kepada murid-murid kita.

Di lain kesempatan, guru-guru juga mengikuti kegiatan donor darah, mereka belajar bagaimana berinteraksi dengan orang baru, dan bagaimana cara tersenyum dan membungkukkan badan untuk berkata Gan en. Seorang guru menyatakan bahwa ternyata rasa syukur itu dapat kita dapatkan dengan mudah, dengan hal-hal kecil yang dilakukan dengan tulus, akan mendapatkan imbalan rasa syukur dan bahagia.

Dengan memiliki cinta kasih dalam hati akan membuat kehidupan menjadi lebih kaya. Dengan menghimpun keberkahan akan menciptakan dunia yang lebih baik dan indah. Seperti kata perenungan Master ini, semoga semakin banyak guru Tzu Chi School yang bergabung menjadi relawan, dan dapat membantu lebih banyak orang lagi sehingga dapat menciptakan dunia yang lebih baik dan indah.

慈·爱人文周

家宠物，让孩子能够近距离与动物相处，了解如何与宠物相处，培养孩子的爱心。来学校做客的有密袋鼠、小猫、小狗、乌龟、鸚鵡等宠物，孩子们轻轻地抚摸鸚鵡的羽毛，喂食物给乌龟，看密袋鼠在空中滑翔。宠物们可爱的动作与逗趣的表情，都被孩子们尽收眼底。期间幼儿园大班的Kimson小朋友分享说：“我们不可以伤害动物，因为它们跟人类一样，会感到痛。” 活动结束后，孩子们也不忘将自己的竹筒奉献出来，希望能帮助到动物收容所里诸多的小动物们。

第二个环节：美食节。在班导师

的带动下一起制作蔬果素食，然后销售给家长们。从决定做哪些食物饮料到制作过程，从食品包装到销售，孩子们全程参与其中。在美食节上，家长们可以买到三明治、手工饼干、爆米花、果冻，以及各式的水果饮料。孩子们大声地叫卖，家长们开心地享受美食，幼儿园里又迎来了久违的喧闹气氛。

第三个环节：生活技能测验。此次活动邀请了慈济学校的中学生来帮忙幼儿园的弟弟妹妹进行此项测验。活动中幼儿园学生需独立完成生活技能，如：扫地、擦桌子、穿脱鞋子和袜子，穿脱校服与折校服等项目，中学的哥哥姐姐们负责讲解测验并层层把关，确保每一位学生都能顺利通关。

第四个环节：话剧表演《精灵国故事》以及《爱吃青菜和水果的鳄鱼与

乳牛》。孩子们摘下口罩，换上表演服，又一次自信地登上舞台，以话剧和歌舞表演的形式，呼吁大家爱护地球，保护环境。多吃水果与青菜，培养孩子们的慈悲心。

此次以慈·爱为主题的人文周在小朋友们捐献竹筒与美食节活动中共得款 Rp 20.000.000。2023年3月3日，由幼儿园校长游翌瑛女士为代表，全额捐献给动物收容所Pejaten Shelter。动物收容所的Dr. Susan对此表达了感谢，并表示慈济学校从幼儿开始就培养孩子们的同理心和慈悲心，是非常成功的教育。

Field Trip To Faunaland and SkyWorld

After two years of having to do virtual field trips, the EC students finally experienced an on-site field trip this term. Field trip is a great way to enhance students' learning experiences by incorporating the community into their curriculum, especially for early childhood students. This real-world setting experience will strengthen their observation skills by immersing them in sensory activities. Furthermore, it has been our commitment to supplement our student's educational experience with various learning activities.

On March 13, 2023, the nursery level students visited Faunaland in Ancol, which is a zoo and conservation center for endemic species such as the African White Lion, White Siamang, and Grizzled Tree Kangaroo. The students had the opportunity to observe these animals up close in a semi-open area. They enjoyed being in a green environment with fresh air and could even pet some animals, such as goats, ponies, donkeys, and turtles. One of the teachers shared that another highlight



of the visit was cruising around the water area to see the activities of the animals that lived there. To conclude their field trip, the students watched a bird show where they could see the birds flying freely and witness professional demonstrations of various attractions.

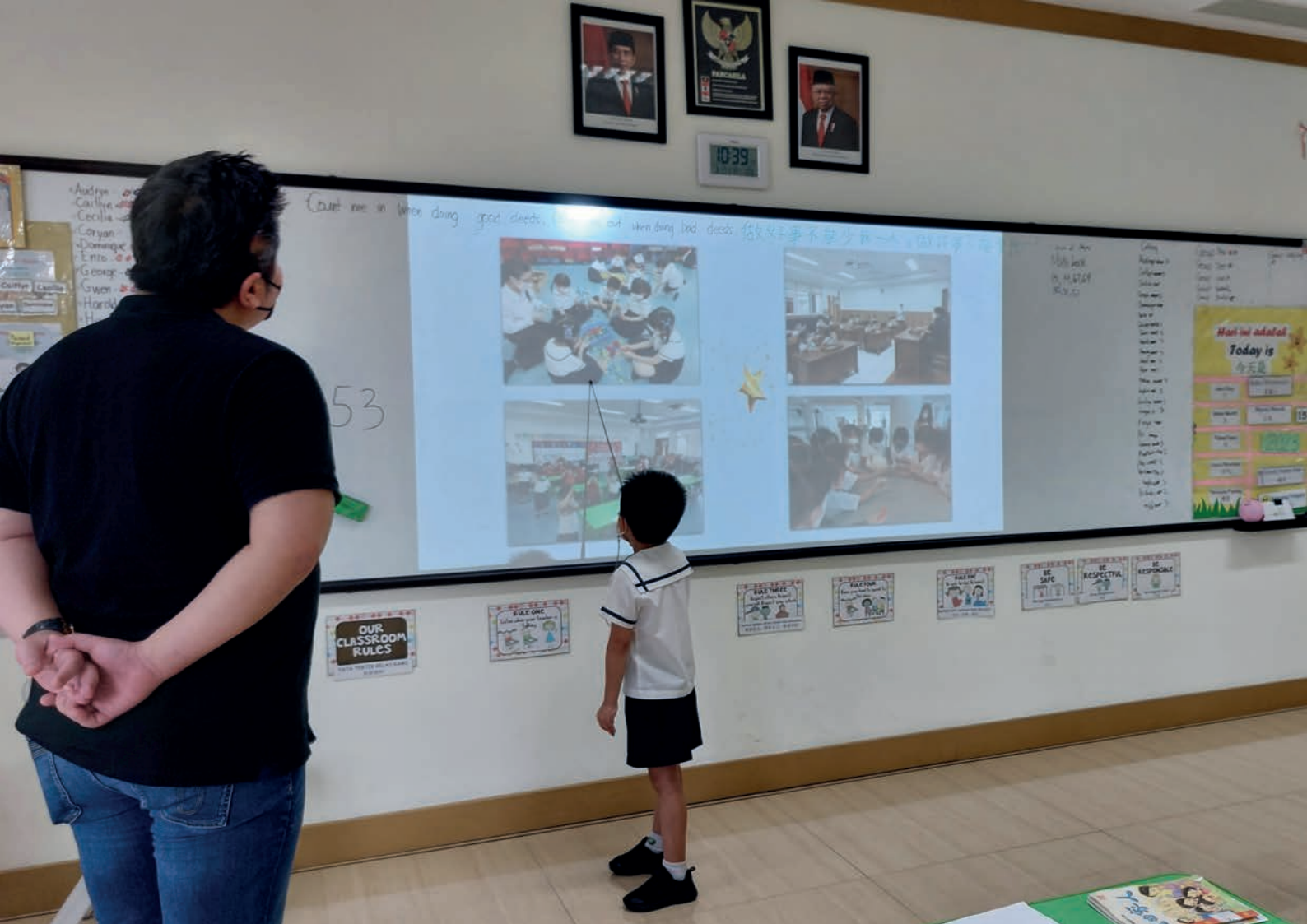
The Kindergarten level students went on a field trip to SkyWorld, an outer space, and aeronautics-themed

educational park, in Taman Mini Indonesia Indah on March 14–15, 2023. The students explored the exhibition area to learn about rockets, astronomers, and planets by observing the displays and listening to the guide's explanations. Some of the students had questions out of curiosity and were able to connect their prior knowledge about the solar system unit that they had previously learned. Additionally, the students participated in a hands-on activity by shooting water rockets, which helped our kinesthetic learners develop their understanding. The field trip program ended with the students watching the planetarium show, which

provided an active learning experience about planets, the sun, the moon, and astronomy. Our students learned new information on this field trip that we hope will stimulate their interest and inspire them to dig deeper into their studies. We were thrilled to be able to do our first field trip safely since the pandemic. We extend our gratitude to all parents, teachers, staff, and students who supported this program. 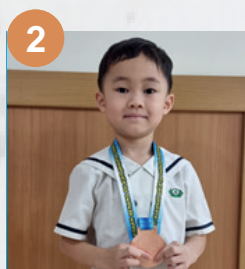

Parents Seminar: Sexuality Education and Building Social Skills in Kids

Seminar kedua pada 24 Februari 2023, berjudul “Membangun Keterampilan Sosial pada Anak,” disajikan oleh Bapak Edwin Nathaniel, M.Psi., membahas pentingnya membekali anak-anak dengan keterampilan sosial ketika mereka masih muda, karena keterampilan ini dapat berkontribusi pada kesuksesan sosial mereka di kemudian hari. Ini bahkan dapat memengaruhi keberhasilan akademis seorang anak saat mereka tumbuh dewasa.

During this 3-day event, the MYP students from grades 7 through 10 showcased their group project for the listed subjects above. The 7th graders constructed a Marble Roller Coaster, an Rube Goldberg Machines from the 8th graders, a Spaghetti Machine from the 9th graders; an interactive Chem Magic from Chemistry classes and a DNA extraction machine demonstration from the Biology classes of grade 10 -all of which were coalesced in accordance with the STEAM's theme for this year, 'connecting ideas through collaboration', and with the sheer intent to display the students' scientific, mathematical and design-related knowledge and skills.

Adding to the vibrance and vibes of this event, the arts students displayed their best art work ranging from
